The bench was purchased by her husband, Mr. Frank Lossy and bears a plaque with the last two lines of the the poem, *Eternity* by William Blake. The bench is located between Building E and the school. Mr. Lossy has been requesting to purchase an additional bench for the last eight years. He seeks a location near his wife's bench that will allow for quiet contemplation and a place to take in the view.

He was originally charged \$110 for the bench. He had the plaque made and park staff affixed it to the bench.
